[Back to the chocolates... These babies are quite delicious. Though most of these bonbons are made of white chocolate, they're pretty good. The one with the peppermint flavored ganache was minty and sweet as a **candy cane**; the **milk and cookies** is quite nostalgic. The **s'mores** was interesting eating a chocolate that tasted like the homey dessert. My dad tried the **egg nog** mainly because of the gorgeous marbling on the outside but he did like the nutmeg blended into this chocolate. My mom enjoyed the **rum raisin** \(the boozy sweetness appeals to her and she adores raisins\). The most intriguing was the **hot toddy** – warm spice notes with a hint of citrus. **White Christmas** was cinnamon-y and nutty \(from hazelnut praline layered in the bonbon\). \(FYI, click on the photo above for bonbon identification.\)](#)
